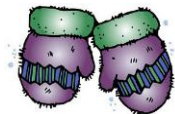
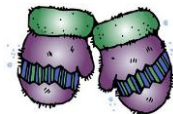
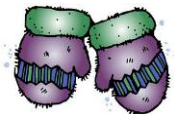

A NOTE FROM OUR HEALTH AIDE

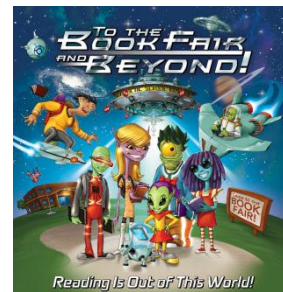
